# **What is a Visual Story?**

**Visual stories are simple and easy to follow. They help people get ready for new places or situations by making things more predictable. This makes the process feel familiar and reduces anxiety and stress.**



The Western Australian Maritime Museum is located at Victoria Quay in Fremantle.

The museum is open every day from 9:30 am to 5:00 pm.

To get there:

- There is parking available near the Museum at paid car parks, including ACROD parking bays.
- It is an 11-minute walk from the Fremantle Train station.

Inside, you will find many interesting displays and exhibits including ones we host all the time, and seasonal displays.



Once you walk into the museum, you can line up for tickets and admission. There is plenty of room for prams and wheelchairs.

The WA Museum is part of the Companion Card program. If you have a Companion Card, you can get free entry for your companion.

The Great Kimberley Wilderness experience is a Virtual Reality (VR) Documentary that runs for 35 minutes.

The session times are:

Monday - Sunday

11am, 12.15pm, 1.30pm, 2.45pm.

School holidays and public holidays

9.45am, 11.00am, 12.15pm, 1.30pm, 2.45pm, 4.00pm.

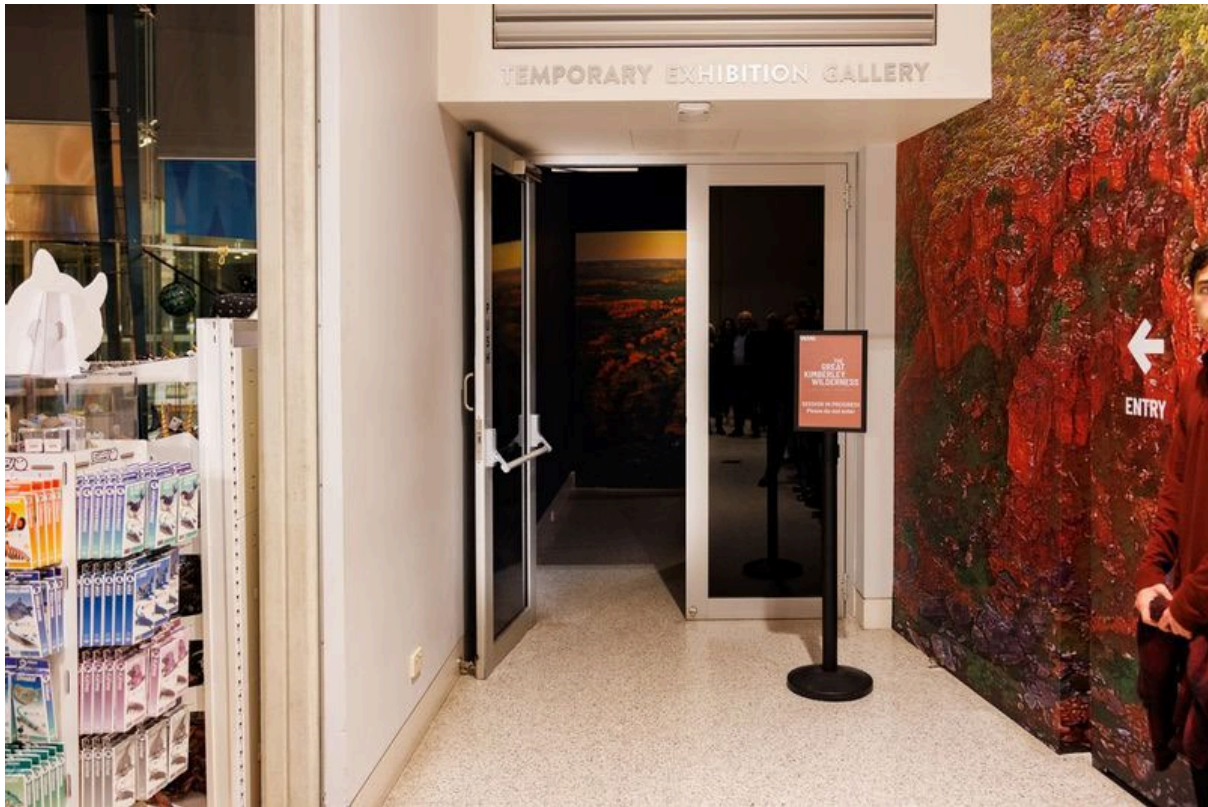
This is a very popular experience, so to avoid disappointment, consider booking your session on the Western Australian Maritime Museum website.

The Great Kimberley Wilderness closes on the 21<sup>st</sup> of June 2026.



After you have purchased your ticket, turn around and you will see a wall display.

There you can line up for your session!



Once your session is about to begin, a friendly museum volunteer will greet you and check your ticket.



Upon entering the exhibition, you are welcome to take a seat on the bench or stand comfortably. A museum volunteer will then guide you through the experience, introducing the documentary and what to expect.



After the museum volunteer has finished introducing the experience, please enter through to the theatre entrance.



As you enter the theatre, you will see rows of chairs with virtual reality (VR) headsets placed on each one, ready for an immersive experience!

Please take a seat.

Don't worry, the museum volunteer will explain how to use the VR!

If you need assistance, a volunteer is there to help. Chairs can be moved for wheelchairs.



A museum volunteer will now explain how to put on and adjust the VR headset. They will ask if anybody needs their help.



Get comfortable and enjoy the documentary!

If you'd like to take a break from the VR headset at any point, you can simply remove it and continue watching the show projected perfectly in sync on the surrounding walls.



After you have enjoyed the show, you can leave to the exit on the left, where you will return to the museum.

We hope you have enjoyed the Great Kimberley Wilderness experience.
